

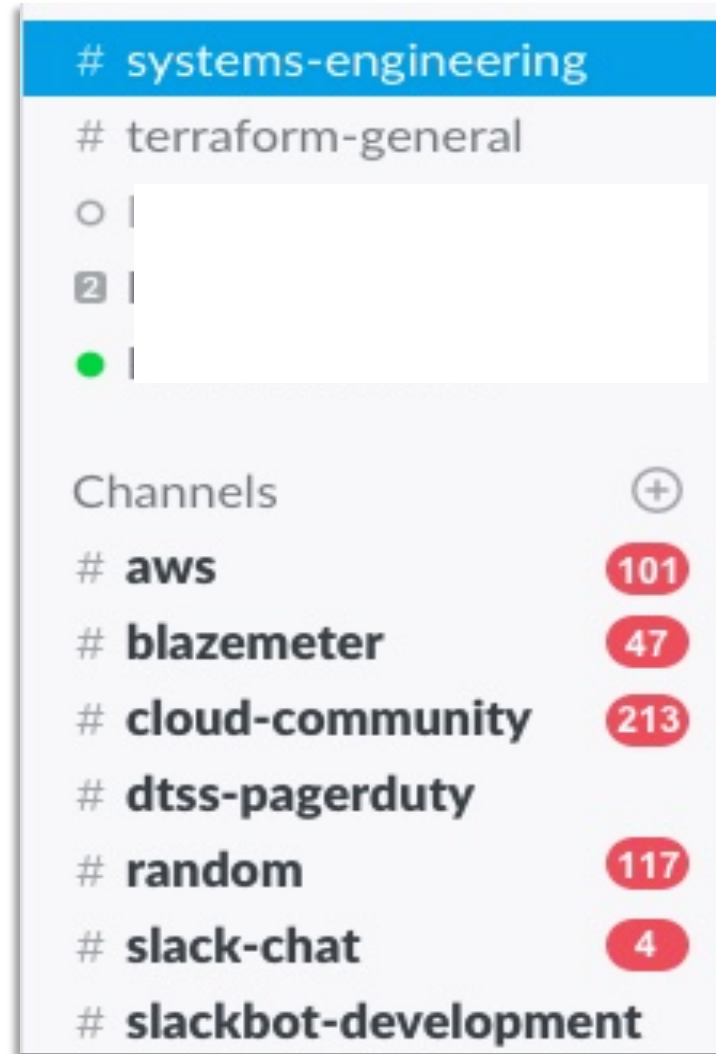

Slack can get out of hand



1. Sidebar preferences

Sidebar

In the sidebar, show:

☐ All my channels, DMs and Apps

☒ Just my unread channels, DMs and Apps

☐ My unreads, along with everything I've starred

Sort my channels:

Scientifically (sorted based on how you use Slack) ▼

☐ List private channels separately

☒ List shared channels separately

☒ Show All Unreads

This collects all the messages you've missed in one handy place.

☐ Show the Quick Switcher

This lets you jump to specific channels and conversations in a snap.

(You can also use `Cmd` `k`)

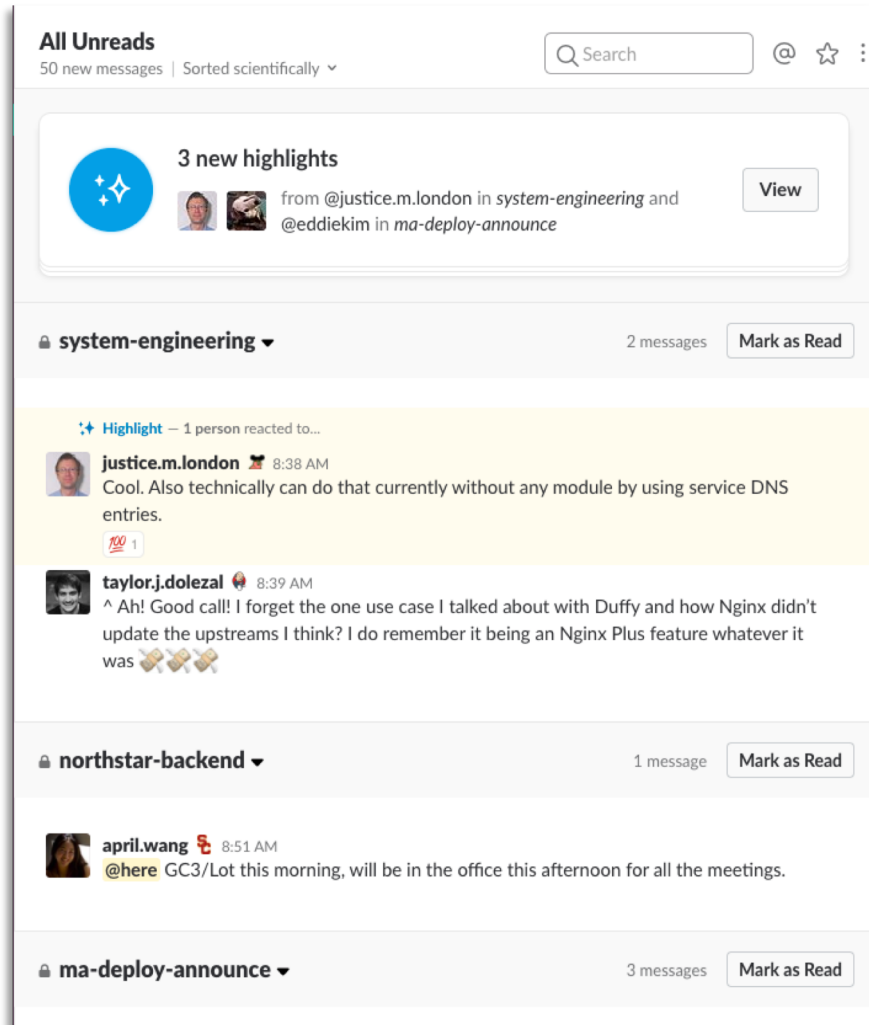
1. Just my unread channels, DMs

2. Scientifically sorted

3. Show 'All Unread'



2. All Unreads



1. Train your 'Highlights'

2. Scroll through quickly

3. Use 'Mark as Read'

4. Use cmd-k to quickly search and jump to Channels

5. Use shift-esc to nuke all messages
